Please arrive **30 minutes** prior to service time.

What to Wear

You will receive a **Baptism** t-shirt on the morning of your baptism to wear into the tank.

We recommend:

- Wearing a tank top or t-shirt underneath (to make changing easier)
 - Dark jeans or black pants
 - Flip flops or slippers (bare feet are easiest for getting in and out of the tank)
